

# Background


- Radio Tower Leases enable MARTA to place radio infrastructure on privately owned towers that will provide radio communications for MARTA's Police Services, Bus Operations and Rail Operations.
- MARTA entered the first lease agreements in 2002 with Crown Castle (Pinnacle Towers, LLC) at Stone Mountain and with American Towers at Union City and Alpharetta on Fulton Industrial.
- In 2003, MARTA added its fourth lease agreement with Georgia Pacific located at 133 Peachtree.
- In April 2023, we went to the board and received approval for all current location leases and are now adding a new location for safety and reliability to our Radio System.




MARTA network map showing Radio Tower sites



## **New Locations**

- MARTA needs to put in-place two lease agreements for the Ravinia Tower location.
  - Dekalb County Sublease
  - Crown Castle Co-location Lease
- Due to the growth and development in North Fulton County the Ravinia Tower is needed to improve the radio communication coverage in the North Fulton County area located in Dunwoody.
- In Clayton County, MARTA added the Panhandle Tower to support the up-and-coming growth in South Clayton County.



### **Financial Considerations**

- Lease Funding expires in 2027 and accounts for existing RF locations
- New Funding (Ravinia Only) will expire in 2034
- MARTA's Internal Audit determined the cost to be fair and reasonable
- Panhandle agreement between MARTA and Clayton County has been executed at a zero dollar value.
- Current Lease Agreement Value: \$4,940,975.59
- Additional Funds Requested: <u>\$ 596,536.20\*</u>
- Total Agreement Amount: \$5,537,511.79



### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MODIFICATION IN CONTRACTRACTUAL AUTHORIZATION FOR THE PAYMENT OF LEASE AGREEMENTS FOR RADIO ANTENNA SITES, L40123

WHEREAS, the Authority's Office of Radio Maintenance has identified the need for the continuous payment of lease agreements for radio antenna sites at the four (4) communications tower locations that support MARTA's Radio Communications Network. These tower sites are positioned at Alpharetta, Union City, Atlanta (Georgia Pacific), and Stone Mountain; and

WHEREAS, the tower sites provide for mobile radio communications coverage with transmittal and receiving capabilities and are leased per existing license agreements; and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2017, the Board of Directors authorized additional funds in the amount of \$1,099,077.80 to continue to make lease payments; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2022, the Board of Directors authorized a modification to extend the term through 2027 and to add additional funds in the amount of \$1,560,687.31 to continue to make lease payments; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2023, the Board of Directors authorized a modification to add additional funds in the amount of \$251,210.48 to continue to make lease payments, add two (2) additional towers at Ravinia and Panhandle as part of the P25 Radio System Upgrade, and to modify equipment on three (3) of the four (4) existing antenna sites; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Internal Audit conducted a price analysis and determined the prices fair and reasonable pricing; and

WHEREAS, all contractual changes and additions for this modification will follow the Authority's procurement policies and guidelines; and

**RESOLVED THEREFORE,** by the Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority that the General Manager/CEO or his delegate be, and hereby is, authorized to increase the authorization for Agreement No. L40123 Lease Agreements for Radio Antenna Sites from \$4,940,975.59 to \$5,539,011.79.
